

Stormwater Management Phase II (Localized) Flood Control Program

Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago (District) is currently accepting applications for the Stormwater Management Phase II (Localized) Flood Control Program. This cost sharing program enables the District to partner with municipalities to implement flood control projects. The District will prioritize submitted projects based on budgetary allocation for the program as well as other factors, such as the project's intended stormwater benefits towards protecting structures from flooding. Example flood control projects include installation of localized detention, upsizing of critical storm sewers and/or culverts, establishment of drainage ways, or installation of any combination of green and grey infrastructure. ASCE EWRI and APWA have invited District staff to provide an overview of their Phase II program.
